

1. Locations at risk of flooding.



Locations at risk of flooding	Trigger Level	er Level Actions	
Russell Terrace Area 1	Water level half way across common, between water course and White Horse Lane.	Alert residents and issue Floodsax.	
White Horse Lane including White Horse Mews and The Paddock (common side) Area 2	Water level a third of the way across the common, between water course and White Horse Lane or reports of high water from property owners.	Alert residents and issue Floodsax.	
St Andrews Church Area 3	Water rising over the church meadow side of the common and/or from the Yare tributary North side of church.	Alert Vicar and remove any perishable items from church if possible. Issue Floodsax.	
Copperdot Dance Studio Area 3	Water rising over the church meadow side of the common and/or from Yare tributary North side of church.	Alert Rachel Brookings and remove any perishable items if possible. Issue Floodsax.	
Whitlingham Lane Area 4	Water rising on the water meadow, Norwich side of Whitlingham Lane.	Alert residents on Whitlingham Lane. Issue Floodsax.	
Newton Close Area 4	Water rising from the ditch on the common.	Alert residents on Newton Close. Issue Floodsax.	

2. Equipment needed.

Location	Equipment needed	Time
Russell Terrace	Floodsax	Can be sourced in 30 minutes
White Horse Lane Including White Horse Mews and The Paddocks	Floodsax	Can be sourced in 30 minutes
St Andrews Church	- Lifting equipment for heavy furniture -Storage (possibly Manor Rooms) -Floodsax	Floodsax can be sourced in 30 minutes but will take longer to arrange lifting equipment and storage. Allow 2 hours
Copperdot Dance Studio	-Lifting equipment for heavy furniture -storage (possibly Manor Rooms) -Floodsax	Floodsax can be sourced in 30 minutes but will take longer to arrange lifting equipment and storage. Allow 2 hours
Whitlingham Lane	Floodsax	Can be sourced in 30 minutes
Newton Close	Floodsax	Can be sourced in 30 minutes

3. Actions flowchart and who does the task.

Residents, Councillors and Parish Clerk to check flood alerts and contact those who may be affected on a door-to-door basis. Roads to be divided up ahead of time to ensure all residents are informed and nobody is missed. See Areas 1-4 above.

Councillors/Parish Clerk

Arrange for the collection/distribution of Floodsax from Parish Council storage facility.

Volunteers/Councillors

Contact Vicar and Copperdot manager about possible flooding

Parish Clerk

Arrange storage of items moved from the church and Copperdot Studios (where possible)

Parish Clerk

Arrange for volunteers to help residents move items to upper floors (where possible)

Councillors and Council Chair

Arrange for vulnerable people to be taken to safety or looked after in their homes as appropriate.

Individual care providers/family members/emergency services

REMEMBER: <u>NOBODY SHOULD PUT THEIR OWN LIVES IN DANGER</u>. If there is a problem the emergency services should be called.
