Cllr Smerdon – updated progress on SAMS where average speeds are now registering 40 mph in the 30 mph zone which can be taken as an improvement over previous recordings. There have been fewer offenders wrongly using the bus gate. Cllr Smerdon reported that he is 2 or 3 forms short for the community volunteers for the Speedwatch initiative.

Cllr Greenizan reported that the retaining wall at the rear of Block Hill Cottages, Nos. 1 -7, does not appear to represent a danger but should be included on the agenda for the next meeting for discussion.
